A three month Foundation course of 'Biodiversity Conservationists' and to be extended as six month course of 'Para-taxonomists' will be held at Botanical Survey of India in collaboration with Zoological Survey of India (ZSI), ENVIS Centre on Floral Diversity (BSI, Kolkata) and ENVIS Centre on Faunal Diversity (ZSI, Kolkata).

As part of "National Skill Development" through the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India in collaboration with Botanical Survey of India and Zoological Survey of India is launching a pilot programme under the Green Skill Development Programme (GSDP) in the form of initial foundation course of three months leading to 'Biodiversity Conservationists' and then extended for another three months as an advanced course specializing to 'Para-taxonomists'.

In this connection, initially 10 districts have been selected for the pilot Launch. These districts are Dehra Dun, South Sikkim, Itanagar, Coimbatore, Pune, Allahabad, Kozhikode (Calicut), Jodhpur, North 24 Parganas and South Andaman.

Eligibility: Candidates with basic qualification of Class-X pass and Class-XII passed/dropouts who were unable to continue their studies should only apply. The Candidates should have basic interest in flora and fauna with working knowledge of English. Candidates from Pune district are preferable. Women candidates are also encouraged to apply.

The Botanical Survey of India, Western Regional Centre, Pune in collaboration with Zoological Survey of India, Western Regional Centre, Pune is seeking good candidates preferably from Pune district, who are interested and having basic knowledge of flora and fauna are requested to appear for the **Walk-in Interview on 07th June 2017 (Wednesday) at 11.00 am** at Zoological Survey of India, Western Regional Centre, Pune along with original documents like School certificates, Mark sheets and Address proof (preferably Aadhar Card).

A Certificate will be awarded to the participants on successful completion of the course.
