

The Koyna region lies at the southern end of the Sahyadri sub clusters and recognized as one of the hotspots among Western Ghats. In 1985, Koyna region was declared as a Wildlife Sanctuary. It derived its name from the river 'Koyna' on which largest dam in Western Ghats was constructed in 1962.
