




Project allotted in 2014: GIS PHYTO-MAPPING & DIGITIZATION OF SHRUBS AND TREES IN AJC BOSE INDIAN BOTANIC GARDEN (JOINTLY)

- •Out of 25 divisions, around 2100 trees and shrubs were serially labelled in 7 divisions and around 90% were identified.
- •Sample Total Station survey work was done for 90 labelled trees in only two hours.
