I am furnishing herewith following major achievements of Botanical Survey of India for the month of July, 2019 in reply to OM no. 24011/08/2019 – GC dtd. 25.03.2019 regarding monthly DO letter from Secretary (E & F) to Cabinet Secretary.

Department: Botanical Survey of India

1. Important policy decisions taken, major achievements during the month:

Species discovered as new to science and species reported for the first time from India

Scientists of BSI discovered and described two new ginger species namely Zingiber perenense and Zingiber dimapurense and one new orchid species namely Rhomboda monensis from Nagaland, North-Eastern India. They also reported Themeda tremula (Poaceae), a new record from Northeast India.

Important meetings attended by Director, BSI during the month:

During the month, Director, BSI attended the CoP 14 meeting at MoEF&CC, New Delhi on 30th July 2019. He also attended a meeting at MoEF&CC, New Delhi and made there a presentation before the new MoS on 9th July 2019. The 25th SAC meeting of GBPNIHESD held at Almora on 16th & 17th July, 2019 was also attended by Director, BSI.

Field Tours conducted:

Five botanical explorations were conducted in various parts of the Western Himalaya and Western Ghats by the scientists of BSI and collectively vouched 508 field nos. Besides, an ethnobotanical survey was conducted to tribal populated district of Bihar and collected 103 field nos. of ethnobotanical species. Similarly, a macrofungal survey and collection tour was undertaken to different parts of North Sikkim and collected the famous caterpillar fungi for macro-morphological study.

Observance of Van Mahotsav and International Yoga Day:

During the month of July, 70th Van Mahotsav was observed throughout BSI. On this occasion, around 29000 plant saplings were distributed and around 3000 mangroves were planted along the Hoogly river bank. The International Yoga Day was also observed on 21st June, 2019.
