I am sending herewith following major achievements of BSI for the month of April, 2019 in reply to OM no. 24011/08/2019 – GC dtd. 25.03.2019 regarding monthly DO letter from Secretary (E & F) to Cabinet Secretary. **Department:** Botanical Survey of India

1. Important policy decisions taken, major achievements during the month:

Scientists of BSI discovered *Phanera murthyii* (Leguminosae: Cercidoideae) from the Western Ghats of Kerala. It appears to be endemic to Kozhikode district, Kerala. They also discovered *Glossocardia andamanica* (Asteraceae) from Andaman and Nicobar Islands. In addition to these, a novel species of macrofungi namely *Marasmius* sect. *Globulares* (Marasmiaceae) has also been discovered from Indian Himalaya. Apart from that *Utricularia uliginosa* Vahl (Lentibulariaceae) has been reported for the first time from Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The annual reports of BSI for the year 2016 – 17 and 2017 – 18 have been published. The Annual Report of 2018-19 is in press. *Important survey conducted:*

Undertaken one Field Survey tour to various localities of East Kolkata Wetland w.e.f. 25th April & 26th April 2019 under EIA Project on East Kolkata Wetland. Collected 22 field nos. of Macro-fungi mainly wood rotting fungi. Some important publications:
