In reply to OM no. 24011/08/2019-GC dated. 25.03.2019 regarding monthly DO letter from Secretary (MoEF&CC) to the Cabinet Secretary, I am furnishing herewith the following major achievements of Botanical Survey of India for the Month of October, 2024. Department: Botanical Survey of India

Important policy decisions taken, Major achievements during the month:

Scientists of BSI described a plant species Gastrodia lohitensis as new to science from Arunachal Pradesh, India, and has been assessed as 'Endangered' according to the IUCN red list criteria. Further, Scientists of BSI conducted 20 field / local tours and 2 HCT and collected 1112 field numbers. BSI prepared metadata of 5813 herbarium specimens. During this month, 13,93,212 visitors visited the official websites of BSI (10,95,699) visitors referred official website, 1,75,237 visitors referred archives, and 1,22,276 visitors visited Indian Virtual Herbarium). Important events / programs organized / attended:

- Dr. A. A. Mao, Director, BSI, received Fellow of the National Academy of Sciences, India (NASI), in recognition of his contributions to angiosperm taxonomy and floristic studies.
- Dr. A. A. Mao, Director, BSI and Dr. C. Murugan, Scientist-F & HoO, BSI, Hqrs., Kolkata attended the "XLVII All India Botanical Conference on Biotic Curiosities and functional diversity across Plant Kingdom in Climate Change Regime" organized by Indian Botanical Society and Department of Microbiology CCS, University, Meerut at CCS University, Meerut from 14 – 16 October, 2024.
- A Laboratory on Geographical Information System (GIS) at the Central National Herbarium (CNH), Howrah was inaugurated by Dr. A. A. Mao, Director, BSI on 24th October 2024.
- The website for the 3rd International Symposium, themed "Changing Paradigm of Indian Flora: Vision 2047," (https://bsiisptebg2025.in) to be held from February 13th to 15th, 2025, to commemorate the 136th Foundation Day was launched by Dr. A.A. Mao, Director, BSI.
- Dr. S.S. Dash, Scientist-F & In-charge, Tech. Sect., BSI-Kolkata delivered a keynote lecture on the "National Symposium Workshop on Conservation of Endemic Species of Eastern Ghats" on 27th October, 2024 at Andhra University, Andhra Pradesh. He also attended the 4th meeting of the Joint Committee constituted by the Hon'ble NGT at New Delhi on 28th October, 2024.
- BSI, ISIM, Kolkata organized 'Travelling Plants' exhibition in collaboration with Goethe Institute, Maxmuller Bhawan and Indian Museum, Kolkata from 06.09.2024 to 04.10.2024 at Indian Museum.
- Under 'Swachata hi Seva' campaign, BSI and all its regional centres organized free health checkup camp for employees on 2nd October
- BSI, Southern Regional Centre, Coimbatore observed its 69th Foundation Day on 10th October 2024, by plantation drives and organizing various programmes.
- A Hands-on training for Multi-Tasking Staff on Nursery Propagation Techniques was organized at BSI, AJC Bose Indian Botanic Garden, Howrah from 14-17 October and 23-26 October 2024 to enhance the skills in various aspects of nursery management.
- A Seven days training/workshop programme on Plant Taxonomy was organized at BSI, ANRC, Port Blair for 30 nos. M.Sc. (Botany) students to impart technical skills on floristic study and conservation techniques on various groups of plants from 15,10,2024 onwards.
- The 'World Food Day' was celebrated at BSI, ISIM, Kolkata on 16th October, 2024 for spreading awareness among visitors and screened a documentary on "Food right & Balance Diet for all".
- BSI, ERC, Shillong participated in Science Festival 2024 on the theme "Science and Technology for Sustainable Development" organized by the Science Departments ,under DBT Star College Scheme Synod College, Shillong and Sponsored by Department of Biotechnology under Ministry of Science and Technology, Govt. of India on 25th October 2024.
- Vigilance Awareness Week was observed in BSI and all its regional centre from 28th October 2024 to 3rd November, 2024 with the theme: "Culture of Integrity for Nation's Prosperity".
- During this month 13 research papers published by BSI Scientists in International and National publications apart from participating in scientific lectures and publishing seminar abstracts. (Annexure 1).
