1. Important policy decisions taken, major achievements during the month:

Scientists of BSI reported **one novel plant species as new to Science** *viz. Strobilanthes lakshminarasimhanii* (Acanthaceae) from the shola forests of Pushpagiri Wildlife Sanctuary in Western Ghats. Besides, **four taxa** viz. *Lactarius abieticola* (Russulaceae), *Apocopis collinus* (Poacecae) have been reported as new addition to India while *Eulophia macrobulbon* (Orchidaceae) and *Cucumis sativus* forma *hardwickii* (Cucurbitaceae) have also been reported as new addition to the Flora of Manipur and Rajasthan states respectively. *Important events / programmes organized / attended:*
