I am furnishing herewith the following major achievements of Botanical Survey of India for the month of May, 2020 in reply to OM no. 24011/08/2019 - GC dtd. 25.03.2019 regarding monthly DO letter from Secretary (E & F) to the Cabinet Secretary.

Department: Botanical Survey of India

Important policy decisions taken, major achievements during the month:

Scientists of BSI reported 4 novel plant species new to science viz. Dipcadi coimbatorensis (Asparagaceae), Eugenia sphaerocarpa (Myrtaceae), Memecylon nervosum (Myrtaceae) from the Western Ghats and Ceropegia khasiana (Apocynaceae) from the North East India. They also reported 3 plant species as new additions to the flora of India / state namely Spermacoce alata, Ipomoea sagittifolia and Rhynchosia nummularia for Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan and Andhra Pradesh respectively and rediscovered an endangered tree Psydrax ficiformis (Rubiaceae) after a century from the Kodaikanal WLS, Tamil Nadu. In addition, BSI completed 11 volumes of Flora of India viz. Vols. 10, 19, 21, 25 & 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31 & 32.

Important event organized during the month:

Observed the International Biodiversity Day 2020 with the theme "our solutions are in nature." On this occasion, various online competitions of drawing, poetry etc. were organized by involving school students and making awareness towards biodiversity conservation.
