ORDER

The appellant had filed a RTI request before the CPIO, Botanical Survey of India vide Registration No. BSOIK/R/E/24/00007 dated 09.04.2024, seeking information under RTI Act 2005.

The CPIO, on receipt of the application, has disposed of the request on dated 28.05.2024, based on the information provided by the BSI, APRC, Itanagar. However, having been dissatisfied with the replies of CPIO, applicant has filed an Appeal to the First Appellate Authority (FAA) vide Registration No. BSOIK/A/E/24/00003 dated 31.05.2024.

Now after receiving the appeal of Shri Tiwari Umed, Mumbai, Maharashtra, the undersigned being the Appellate Authority has gone through the RTI request lodged by him and the reply furnished by CPIO, BSI and found that the appellant has made the appeal not against the information provided by the CPIO but sought or raised new queries.

In this connection, the undersigned is to state that, According to RTI Act 2005, an appeal can be made against any reply/information/incomplete/misleading or false information provided by the CPIO. Since the applicant has not raised any objection against the reply of CPIO, BSI, there is no scope to take any further action by the First Appellate Authority (FAA).

In view of the above, the appeal is thus accordingly disposed of.

ORDER

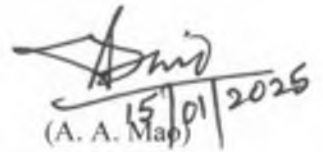
The appellant had filed a RTI request before the CPIO, Botanical Survey of India vide Registration no. BSOIK/R/E/24/00034 dated 01/12/2024, seeking information under RTI Act 2005.

The CPIO, on receipt of the RTI application, has collected the available information from relevant sections of the BSI as desired by the applicant and thereafter vide this office letter no. BSI-21/01/2022-24/15065, CPIO has requested to applicant for payment of an additional amount of Rs. 22/- (Twenty two only) being charges of copy of the document (@2/- rupees per page for 11 pages), by means of IPO, D.D., Bankers check etc., (which should be drawn in the name of PAO BSI/ZSI Kolkata), or by Cash under proper receipt as prescribed in RTI ACT, 2005. through RTI-MIS portal (online) and also through Indian speed post on dated: 23/12/2024 which was undelivered and back to this office on 30/12/2024, due to address not provided properly by the applicant/ insufficient address.

Now, after receiving the appeal of Mr. Imtiaz Biswas, the undersigned being First Appellate Authority (FAA) has carefully examined the RTI application dated 01/12/2024 and CPIO letter no. BSI-21/01/2022-24-Adm./15065 Dated 23/12/2024 and found that under above noted letter reference, applicant was being requested to deposit Rs. 22/- (Rupees Twenty-two only) @2/- rupees per page as prescribed in RTI Act 2005 for 11 pages document, through RTI-MIS portal as well as Indian speed post. Moreover, by not taking cognizance of the reply/letter sent by the CPIO and without paying the additional charges, the applicant filed the appeal.

Hence, in view of the above, there is no reason/scope to interfere with the decision of the CPIO, Botanical Survey of India, and Mr. Imtiaz Biswas hereby asked to deposit the said amount through valid means of payment gateway to receive the information as sought by him.

The appeal is thus accordingly **disposed of**.

ORDER

The appellant had filed a RTI request before the CPIO, Botanical Survey of India vide registration no. BSOIK/R/E/24/00029 dated 24/11/2024, seeking information under RTI Act 2005.

The CPIO, on receipt of the RTI application through RTI-MIS portal on date 24/11/2024, found that there was no document attached with the RTI application. Therefore, on the very next day i.e. on 25/11/2024, CPIO returned the RTI application with remarks; *'The document attached at the time of filing RTI request is not accessible. The same document may please be uploaded to process your RTI Request'*.

On receiving the appeal of Smt. Arti Garg, Dehradun, Uttarakhand ref. no. BSOIK/A/E/25/00002 date 24/01/2025, the undersigned being First Appellate Authority (FAA) has carefully examined the RTI application dated 24/11/2024 and found that, The CPIO had requested for supporting document which was not found with RTI application. Without taking the cognizance of the reply sent by the CPIO through RTI-MIS portal, the appellant filed an appeal to the First Appellate Authority (FAA). However to obtain the desired information, the appellant has to upload/submit document on RTI-MIS portal as requested by CPIO.

Hence, in view of the above, there is no reason/scope to interfere with the decision of the CPIO, Botanical Survey of India. In order to obtain the desired information sought by Smt. Arti Garg, is being hereby asked to upload/submit the said document through RTI-MIS portal/post.

The appeal is being disposed of accordingly.

In case the Appellant is aggrieved by the decision, she is free to file second appeal, if she so desires, before the Central Information Commission, Baba Gang Nath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 against this order within 90 days.
